Obtaining a Complete Evaluation

Individuals with foreign transcripts, degrees, and other relevant documents are responsible for obtaining a complete evaluation of these documents prior to applying for Registry membership. The Registry does not accept translated transcripts but evaluated transcripts only.

Type of Evaluation Report

Students with a high school diploma should obtain a **general evaluation report**.

Students who have earned credits beyond high school should obtain a **course by course report**.

Please note that each college/university or employer in the United States is autonomous and may have their own unique requirements. If you are unsure whether evaluation reports are accepted by your intended institution or employer, please check with the institution or employer.
